

**QUEEN'S COLLEGE JUNIOR SCHOOL, TAUNTON**  
**Uniform for both Junior Boy and Girl Boarders**  
**Effective from Autumn Term 2011**

Articles marked with an **asterisk** are regulation uniform and **must** be obtained from the School Shop. All items on the clothing list, with the exception of shoes, can be purchased in the School Shop at prices comparable to those in the high street stores.

The Shop is open during term-time on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays from 1.00 – 5.00pm. It operates extended opening at the end of term and the beginning of term, details of which will be advised in a mailing to parents and/or through the Shop. If you are obtaining uniform for a new pupil, you are asked to make an appointment by contacting the Manageress of the School Shop. For appointments or other enquiries, she can be contacted on **01823 251887 during normal shop opening hours.**

Please would parents check that all articles are in a good state of repair at the beginning of each term. We assume that any missing, worn out or outgrown articles not already on order from the School Shop may be obtained by us and put on the Bill. We would always consult a child's parents or guardians for permission to replace major items.

**MEDICAL DETAILS**

1. If a child has been in the care of a Doctor during the school holidays a brief note from him to the school Medical Officer should be sent so that the child's medical records can be kept up to date.
2. It is strongly recommended that children should visit their DENTIST twice a year and during a School holiday.
3. If a child wears glasses, please supply Matron with a marked spare pair.
4. O-pro Mouthguard fittings will take place throughout the school during the first week of the Autumn term. Please see O-pro leaflet for details and ordering.

**PLEASE NOTE**

Storage space for clothes is limited, so please adhere to the **number** of items stated on the list. We will replace toiletries as necessary. If a child wishes to use conditioners please add one to the list. Hair dryers are supplied by the School. **NO aerosols sprays** and no talcum powder please.

**Penknives** or torches are NOT allowed. ONLY Year 7 may have a mobile phone. This must be clearly marked and handed to boarding staff for safekeeping. iPod's, MP3's, gameboys, PSP's etc may be brought back to school provided they are clearly marked with child's name and are handed into a member of boarding staff for safekeeping. All such items will be locked away during school time and overnight.

**FIRST DAY**

Children should arrive at School in School Uniform.

**TRUNKS AND TRUNK KEYS**

Please mark trunks clearly with the child's name on the OUTSIDE. Trunk keys will be kept by Matron during the term, and should be attached to a tie-on label bearing the child's name.

**MARKING AND LOOPING**

**Every article of clothing (including detachable items like belts and parka hoods all underwear and socks) must be marked with the child's name in woven name tapes.** These can be purchased through the School Shop. Delivery is normally one week, but please allow 2 weeks at busy times of the year. The child's name should also be clearly marked on boots and shoes.

All other possessions brought to school (including toilet requisites) must be clearly marked with the child's name. Watches should be engraved. We strongly recommend that children do not bring expensive personal possessions to school. Jewellery is NOT allowed, except plain stud earrings for girls with pierced ears, neither are mobile telephones (except for year 7).

Please ensure that when boarders return after "sleepouts" any replacement belongings, particularly playclothes and underwear, are named.

Sports clothes and towels must have LOOPS attached for hanging.

**ALL articles of sports clothing MUST have large gold on black name tapes sewn ON THE OUTSIDE, on the front right hand side (as you look at the garment, below the logo if present) wherever possible.**
