## Uniform List

### **Girls Winter Uniform:**

- Q Regulation skirt (pleated skirt for Years 7-11 and a pencil skirt option for Years 10-11)
- O School blazer
- Q Black V-neck pullover with gold piping (optional for wearing under blazer)
- O School tie
- O White school shirt with formal 'classic collar'
- O Black tights
- Q Plain black leather or patent leather shoes (no 'shoe jewellery') No platforms, stilettos or fashion pumps. Flat shoes must have a rubber sole with low heels (lower than 1½ inches)
- Q Jacket, anorak or coat Gabardine, cotton or acrylic, not leather or fur. Must be dark in colour.
- O Plain white or flesh coloured bras only

### **Boys Winter Uniform:**

- Q Regulation trousers
- Q School blazer
- Q Black V-neck pullover with gold piping (optional for wearing under blazer)
- O School tie
- O White school shirt with formal 'classic collar'
- O Grey or black socks
- Q Plain black polishable leather shoes
- Q Jacket, anorak or coat-Gabardine, cotton or acrylic, not leather or fur. Must be dark in colour.

#### **Girls Summer Uniform:**

As above except.

- Q Plain white short-sleeved school blouse (revere collar) In place of shirt and tie
- Q Natural or nude-coloured tights or white ankle socks

### **Boys Summer Uniform:**

As above except.

# Uniform and Appearance:

### **Labelling Of Clothing**

All clothing and equipment should be named on the inside of the garment. No clothing or equipment should be borrowed without the owner's consent. All clothing should be neat and tidy and kept clean.

### Hair, Make Up And Jewellery

At Sixth Form level, pupils may wear make-up and jewellery which is unobtrusive - ie a single ring, non-pendant earrings in the earlobe and/or a single gold or silver chain necklace. The Head of Sixth Form will give guidance and these privileges will be withdrawn if abused.

### **Appearance At School**

The dress and appearance of pupils must at all times reflect well on the individual and the school.

Pupils are required have a high standard of personal hygiene and clean shaven.

Uniform should be worn neatly while attending school and in travelling to school unless an explicit exception has been made by a member of staff.

Jackets must be worn when travelling to and from School and throughout the school day.

Uniform must always be worn in detention.

The wearing of games kit in the Dining Room is not permitted, save on specified occasions when tracksuits should be worn.

Uniform must be worn until 5.30 pm on weekdays and into all weekday meals except supper.

Hats and caps and other items of casual clothing may not be worn with uniform at any time.

Boarders may wear informal clothes in supper (but not hats) and on Saturday and Sunday, except for formal school engagements, fixtures, team teas etc. A mixture of informal clothes and uniform is not allowed.

All items of uniform must conform to the school regulations. Outer garments – raincoats, anoraks etc – must be smart, dark in colour and without logos. Pupils who cycle to school should wear a reflective strip. The wearing of cycle helmets is strongly recommended.

Regulation uniform, colours blazers and sports kit must be obtained from Perry Uniform at prices comparable to those in the high street stores.
