At Queen's College Prep our Co-Curricular programme offers a variety of activities that help our pupils to realise their potential in a variety of ways. Our diverse range of activities are integral to the school day and very much part of the curriculum.

Years 4, 5 & 6 pupils are expected to attend Co-Curricular 1 everyday. Year 3 pupils have two Co-Curricular activities per week where they are all expected to attend, though of course are welcome to choose additional options on other days.

Some Co-Curricular 2s are necessary and therefore compulsory.

Some additional activities take place after 5:30pm. In these cases please collect pupils promptly from the activities afterwards as late-care ends at 6:00pm.



The range of activities available gives pupils the chance to embrace the opportunities on offer, challenging themselves and broadening their experiences.

Co-Curricular 1 is 3:40pm - 4:25pm.
Pupils then have a ten minute break.

Co-Curricular 2 starts at 4:35pm - 5:25pm.

Athletics

Children will have the opportunity to try a variety of different athletic events in preparation for sports day.

Art Club

We will be doing a number of short drawing and painting activities.

Board Games (Years 4-6)

Traditional and newer version board games will be played. The rules of the games will be learnt as well as how to play fairly! Children could even bring in their favourite game to teach to others.

Bucket Drumming

Come and have fun drumming on buckets!!! We will play ensemble pieces and enjoy improvising together.

Choir (All Years 3 & 4)

This is a fun choir singing lots of different songs (often funny!) working towards the Summer concert.

Comic Making/Mindfulness Colouring

A chance to look at different styles of comic and to get creative with drawing and writing one's own comics or relax with some mindfulness colouring.

Construction Club

The children will be set a weekly construction challenges to complete either with a partner or individually.

DT Club

Get creative with this fun design club.

Cosmic Yoga

Learning some specific poses as well as following the full cosmic kids yoga classes which are based around stories and adventures.

Football

A chance to develop footballing skills, build experience and most importantly have fun.

Games

As Year 3 and 4 Games lessons take place on the Lower, which takes a bit of time to get down and back, this lesson extends into CC1 on Mondays to allow time for a full session and changing! There will also be the occasional match.

Speech lessons will continue as before. Children will be allocated a time-slot on return to school. There is a charge of £59.50 per term.

Swimming Training/Matches (All Years)

These sessions double up as training sessions and swimming matches for identified swimmers who are aiming to represent the school. Either session can be selected by the children depending on other CC choices. When Galas take place, the children will either be competing or will

need join an alternative activity.

Tennis

A coaching lesson aimed at improving technique and developing an understanding of the rules. Pupils should bring their own racket.

Years 5 & 6

Aikido

Aikido is a non competitive martial art from Japan. Learn a series of throws and immobilisation techniques, using the attacker's strength and momentum against them. As Aikido relies on skill and not strength, it can be practised by anyone. Run by a qualified instructor. A charge of £5 per week will be added to the termly bill.

Archery

A chance to try a new sport with our qualified school instructors. Great for those looking to get the Blue Peter Sports Badge!

Transition Art Club- Year 6

An Art club run to help Year 6 transition into the Senior School. We will familiarise ourselves with the Art Department and will use as much art equipment as we can fit into the term! We will paint, print and etch and will use nature as our theme.

Board Games

Traditional and newer version board games will be played. The rules of the games will be learnt as well as how to play fairly! Children could even bring in their favourite game to teach to others.

Book Club

Come along and share a book. Reading or audio. We will choose a title or author to look at each week. Or you can just come along and disappear into your own book!

Cookery Club

Calling all budding chefs! Cookery Club will be a chance for pupils to learn and practise new skills in the kitchen. The club will take place in the food tech room each Monday and we will prepare and make a new dish every week. Children will also have the opportunity to try new foods and discover ingredients from across the world.

Drama Club

Dog Training

Fencing

An introduction to Fencing with a Level 3 qualified instructor. Charges of £5 per session apply. Maximum group size of 12.

An opportunity for the girls to get back on the hockey pitch and hone their skills. It is hoped that those with ambitions to play 'A' team hockey will sign up.

Junior Hip-Hop

A new inclusive Hip-Hop class for all levels. Charges of £62.15 per term will be applied to the termly bill.
