TAUNTON IS EASILY ACCESSIBLE, WITH GREAT TRANSPORT LINKS.

Taunton is located on Junction 25 of the M5 motorway, a 2.5 hour drive south-west of London. Taunton can also be easily accessed by train with frequent trains direct from London Paddington to Taunton Train Station. Bristol Airport is a one hour drive away, while Heathrow Airport is a 2.5 hour drive away.



TAUNTON IS THE COUNTY TOWN OF SOMERSET.

A bustling market town which hosts a number of excellent markets, restaurants, shops and green spaces.
